ACTION REQUEST: Change in Title of an Existing Academic Administrative Position
CURRENT TITLE: Associate Dean for Academic Affairs, School of Information
RECOMMENDED TITLE: Associate Dean for Academic Programs, School of Information
EFFECTIVE DATE: October 1, 2024

The School of Information wishes to recommend a change in title of an existing academic administrative position from associate dean for academic affairs, to associate dean for academic programs, School of Information, effective October 1, 2024.

The School of Information continues to grow and develop innovative programs. Our student body has increased by 72% over the last 10 years. In addition, we have, together with the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts, and the College of Engineering, started a new undergraduate concentration (informatics). Given the growing size and complexity of our academic programs, the size and complexity of the workload expected of the associate dean for academic affairs has significantly increased. We will be able to better serve our students by changing this administrative position to a more narrowly focused appointment specifically in charge of academic programs; the current position title also encompasses many responsibilities for faculty life.

The associate dean for academic programs will have lead responsibility for student experience and the content and management of our academic programs (master's, doctoral, and our participation in the undergraduate Informatics program). This will include oversight over student recruiting, admissions, orientation, advising and student life, practical engagement and career placement; curriculum planning, teaching assignments and scheduling; degree and other academic program development; and program assessment.

This position will take leadership on special projects and be responsible for the academic programs budget. The associate dean for academic programs will coordinate with a new administrative position we are creating, senior associate dean for faculty, and will report to the dean. We are pleased to recommend the change in title of an existing academic administrative position from associate dean for academic affairs, to associate dean for academic programs, School of Information, effective October 1, 2024.
